2013 Cub Scout Summer Camps

The Cub Scout Summer Camp program for the Glacier's Edge Council is designed to provide an age appropriate progression of activities for our Packs and the families they serve. Packs are encouraged to consider the age level opportunities as they plan their Pack program to keep things new and exciting for the Scouts. The Rank level suggestions given below are for the rank the Cub Scout will hold in Fall 2013.



Tiger Camps: Tiger Cub Scouts will enjoy Crafts, Nature, Sports, Games and other activities designed especially for them. Tiger Camp will be offered as a Twilight session at Token Creek and as one day program at Camp Indian Trails. Required Rank: Tiger Cubs



Day Camps: Program at all camps will include BB guns, Archery, Crafts, Nature, Sports, Games and other activities. Day Camp at Camp Indian Trails also has swimming and climbing. Options for overnight Pack Camping will be available at Brigham, Token Creek and Camp Indian Trails. Recommended Rank Wolf, Bear, Webelos I

Cub Scout Resident Camps at Camp Indian Trails: This program will feature Shooting Sports, Swimming in the CIT Pool, Craft, Nature, Sports, Climbing and other activities. Campers will rotate through activities on a set schedule. Evening Campfires will round out the program. Resident Camp includes overnight stay. Campers arrive in the afternoon of day 1 and depart camp on the afternoon of day 3. Campers need to bring their personal gear clothes, sleeping gear and tents. All meals are provided by Camp. Recommended Rank: Wolf, Bear and Webelos I Scouts.

Cub Scout resident Camp - Boy Scout Preview at Ed Bryant Scout Reservation: Cub Scouts will get a taste of Boy Scout Camp by joining the Boy Scout campers at EBSR for dinner and the Boy Scout closing campfire. The following day as the Boy Scouts head home the Cub Scouts will enjoy a fun filled day of Shooting Sports, Waterfront (swimming, pontoon boat rides and kayaks), Crafts, Nature, Sports and other activities. Activities are offered on an open schedule allowing campers to sample all of the activities or spend as long as they wish at their favorite station. Boy Scout Preview Camp includes overnight stay. Campers arrive Friday afternoon and depart camp about noon on Sunday. Campers need to bring their personal gear, clothes, sleeping gear and tents. All meals are provided by Camp. Recommended Rank: Open to Wolf, Bear, and Webelos Scouts.



Webelos Shooting Sports Camp: A special day or twilight camp designed for Webelos Scouts. Scouts attending this program will earn the BB Gun and Archery Shooting Sport pins. Recommended Rank: Webelos II (Webelos I allowed if space permits)

Webelos Expedition at Ed Bryant Scout Reservation: Webelos Expedition in early May is an overnight camp followed by day of fun activities capped off by a very special "Blessing of the Arrows" ceremony to send the Webelos Scouts on the final leg of their journey of Cub Scouting and on to their Arrow of Light Award. Required Rank: Webelos I in May 2013 (will be Webelos II in Fall 2013).

Camp Akela Webelos Resident Camp at Camp Indian Trails: Camp Akela, the Glaciers Edge Webelos Resident Camp, helps Webelos with their journey to becoming a Boy Scout. Campers will work on Activity Pins and enjoy Swimming, Shooting Sports, Climbing and other activities. Camp Akela campers will stay on site at Camp Indian Trails. Campers arrive in the afternoon of day 1 and depart camp on the morning of day 4. Campers need to bring their personal gear, clothes, sleeping gear and tents. All meals are provided by Camp. Recommended Rank: Webelos II, Webelos I are also welcome.

Selecting a Cub Scout Camp:

Camps offered at Brigham Park, Camp Carlson, and Token Creek Park are run by adult volunteers under the direction of a BSA National Camp School trained volunteer Camp and Program Directors. Packs attending these camps are required to provide leaders for supervision of your Pack and to help run stations. If your Pack cannot meet the requirement to provide adult staff, we encourage you to attend a Day Camp or Cub/Webelos Resident Camp session at Camp Indian Trails or Ed Bryant Scout Reservation. Glacier's Edge Council Camps at CIT and EBSR have staff to run the camp so Packs will only need enough adult leaders to meet the minimum set by the camp for supervision of your Pack. All Cub Scout camps at Camp Indian Trails and Ed Bryant Scout Reservation can accommodate individual Scouts with an adult partner.
