# Catholic Religious Awards for Girl Scouts & Boy Scouts

## Girl Scout:

### **Family of God** for Brownie Girl Scouts (grades 1-3)

The purpose of the *Family of God* program is to help children explore a wide range of activities to discover the presence of God in their daily lives as members of their family and parish. Booklet Cost: \$6.00

### **I Live My Faith** for Junior Girl Scouts (grades 4-6)

*I Live My Faith* is an action-oriented program activities that focuses on developing awareness within the individual of her potential as a growing person, friend, family member, citizen, and a participant in the community of faith. An important part of the program is the involvement of parents in the process of faith sharing. Booklet Cost: \$6.00

### **Mary, the First Disciple** for Cadette Girl Scouts (grades 7-9)

Through *Mary, the First Disciple*, young Catholics will grow in appreciation of Mary and in understanding themselves. Booklet Cost: \$6.00

### **Spirit Alive** for Senior Girl Scouts (grades 10-12)

*The Spirit Alive* program assists young Catholic women in discovering how the Holy Spirit moves in their lives, calling them to greater participation in the Church's ministry. Booklet Cost: \$6.00

## Boy Scouts:

### **Light of Christ** for Tigers and Wolves (must be completed by end of 2<sup>nd</sup> grade)

The purpose is to help the Cub develop a personal relationship with Jesus. With the parents' active assistance and participation in this program, it is hoped that the Cub will come to see Jesus as a real person and his friend. Booklet Cost: \$4.00

### **Parvuli Dei** for Bears and Webelos (must have completed 2<sup>nd</sup> grade to begin on this award)

The purpose of the *Parvuli Dei* (Children of God) emblem is to help young boys explore a wide range of activities in order to discover the presence of God in their daily lives as members of their families and parishes, and also to develop a good, positive self-image through the contributions they can make to the group or community. Booklet Cost: \$4.00

### **Ad Altare Dei** for Scouts that have completed 6<sup>th</sup> grade (designed for scouts age 13-14)

The purpose of the *Ad Altare Dei* (to the altar of God) program is to help Catholic Scouts develop a fully Christian way of life in the faith community. The program is organized in chapters based on the seven Sacraments. The seven Sacraments are a primary means toward spiritual growth. Booklet Cost: \$4.00

### **Pope Pius XII** for Boy Scouts, including Venture Young Men and Women – must be at least in 9<sup>th</sup> grade (age 14-21)

The purpose of the *Pope Pius XII* program is to challenge the candidate to evaluate his or her own personal talents and abilities in light of a possible choice of lifestyle/vocation or ministry that relates in some way to belonging to and becoming increasingly more active in the Catholic Christian faith community. Also, it gives the candidate an opportunity to share faith and practice his/her religion among peers, while receiving guidance and feedback attuned to the ideals of Scouting. Booklet Cost: \$4.00
